SCHOLARSHIP

RECIPIENT CRITERIA

1. The recipient shall be a female graduate of a Kerr County accredited high school or have earned a GED certificate.
2. There shall be no discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, or national origin.
3. The recipient must show evidence of having the potential to pursue higher education and have the desire to do so.
4. When all other criteria is equal, greater consideration will be given to the applicant evidencing the greater need or who has no other means of financial assistance available.
5. This scholarship will be renewable annually for four years in the amount of \$2,000.00 per year as long as the recipient maintains a minimum 2.5 GPA and is registered as a full time student with 12 or more hours at an accredited college or four year university. The recipient must submit her grades to the scholarship committee each semester to determine eligibility.
6. The recipient shall be selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Executive Women's Club.
7. Applicants may come from:
  - A. Lists of names submitted by area high school scholarship committees
  - B. Applications received from prospective recipients.
  - C. Names submitted by members of the Executive Women's Club.
8. Notification of the award will be made at the May meeting of the Club and at Graduations Ceremonies, if applicable.
9. Executive Women's Club members and their families are excluded from the application process.
